«The new Travel Shopper is our essential lightweight item for journeys close and far. It was born from a collaboration between QWSTION and Swiss product designer Sibylle Stöckli, and unites the focus on simplicity with observations made while traveling into the unknown.

Sibylle Stöckli navigates between her textile label and her studio where she develops scenography and furniture design. She was one of the first designers to be invited by Qwstion to present her products in our flagship store.

In 2012 she initiated Global Design Research, a project involving discussions with designers and craftsmen about their disciplines in context of cultures.

The aim is to reflect on how objects are influenced by cultural habits and how they relate to know-how of industry and crafts. In a wider perspective it is a study on sustainability in our globalized world.

After returning from her research trip to 26 global cities on all five continents we started collaborating to create a bag that is made for explorers. Like us, Sibylle Stöckli is constantly questioning norms.»

- The QWSTION + Sibylle Stöckli Travel Shopper is a lightweight, undercover bag to bring along wherever you're heading.

As all our bags it offers multiple carrying options, and in spite of its simplicity can be carried as a backpack when you need your hands free.

It was developed in close collaboration with Swiss designer Sibylle Stöckli.

Guided by her eclectic approaches and the diversity of her interests, she opens the boundaries of her design practice and reflects on several research projects as 'Global Design Research', a World Tour across the 5 continents or the G.R.I.D. Institute where she currently develops a Master degree.
